Program Summary: When the ca. 1851 Presbyterian Church (later Congregational and now Masonic Lodge) was constructed, a large bell was purchased from Andrew Meneely and Son of West Troy, New York. A clock from the firm of Austin Van Riper of Cazenovia, New York was installed in the new church in 1852. The program will review the history of both the Meneely bell and the Van Riper town clock companies and the Keeseville clock and bell.

Guest Speaker: G. Russell Oechsle of Homer, NY has researched upstate New York clocks and clock makers for over 40 years.
